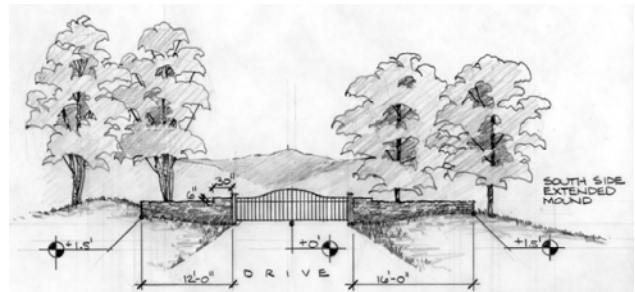
*Do you work in the fields of landscape or garden design,

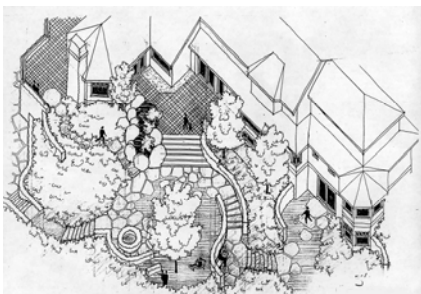
